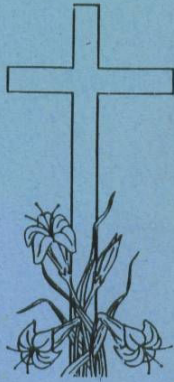

Andre Gumbs, affectionately known as "Andy", was born on November 25, 1934 to Eugenie and John C. Gumbs.
