At the age of four she came to St. Thomas, Danish West Indies, to live with her aunts Eudora "Miss Dory" Hughes, an excellent cake maker and Isabel Hughes, a seamstress, who lived on Kronprindsens Gade across from Mr. Barzey's Shoemaker shop.

Eulalia was a member of Sts. Peter and Paul Roman Catholic Cathedral and received her education at Sts. Peter and Paul School. She was married to Louis E. Greaux (deceased) and had five children: Ruth Greaux Shulhoff, Gustave, Wilbur (deceased), Roland and Reed Greaux.

Mrs. Greaux worked for several local businesses including L'Escale Shop at the airport and her last place of employment, Mr. Woody's store from which she retired.
