Jean Joseph "Tweeny" Greaux was born on February 11, 1968 to Thomas and Ann Greaux on St. Thomas. He was the third of five children. Tweeny attended the Sts. Peter and Paul School and later went on to Charlotte Amalie High School. Tweeny had a very active childhood that included many outdoor activities such as swimming and fishing. He also volunteered as a summer camp counselor and enjoyed drawing in his spare time.

On July 21, 1996, Tweeny had a son, Jamal Jordan Greaux with Nicole Swan. Jamal resides on St. Thomas with his mother.

Five years ago, Tweeny moved to Houston, Texas where he met his wife Romy. They were married in 2001. He worked as a cook for The Company Kitchen, an affiliate of SEARCH, a leading homeless service provider. Tweeny often expressed how much he enjoyed his job and his relationship with his co-workers.
