Louis Armour was born to Anne Louise Questel and Theodore Frederick Magras in St. Thomas, Virgin Islands on December 27, 1915. He was best known by all his family and friends as "Armour." He was married to Augustine Magras for fifty and one-half wonderful years. They celebrated their wedding anniversary on Thanksgiving Day, November 28, 1985, which turned out to be a very special and most happy occasion. Together with them were their six children; Bernadette (or Bonnie), Eileen, Barbara, Ricky, Evan and Jimmy — joined by some close relatives and friends. Although he never ventured far from home, Armour had many friends. His entire life was devoted to his family. Everything about him was simple and he lived a simple life.

Throughout his lifetime there were many rough roads for Armour to walk, but his faith and courage always pulled him through. He was a loving husband, father and grandfather, and was loved dearly in return. He had a very strong faith and a great devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus and the Sacred Heart of Mary. He was called by his creator from this world on April 14, 1992.

Let this love be shown among you by a spirit of tenderness and understanding. Be slow to anger and seek to heal one another's wounds. Let the bonds of unity and love bind your hearts together and may the legacy of love he has left you be passed on to others. This will be the only befitting tribute to such a loving soul.
