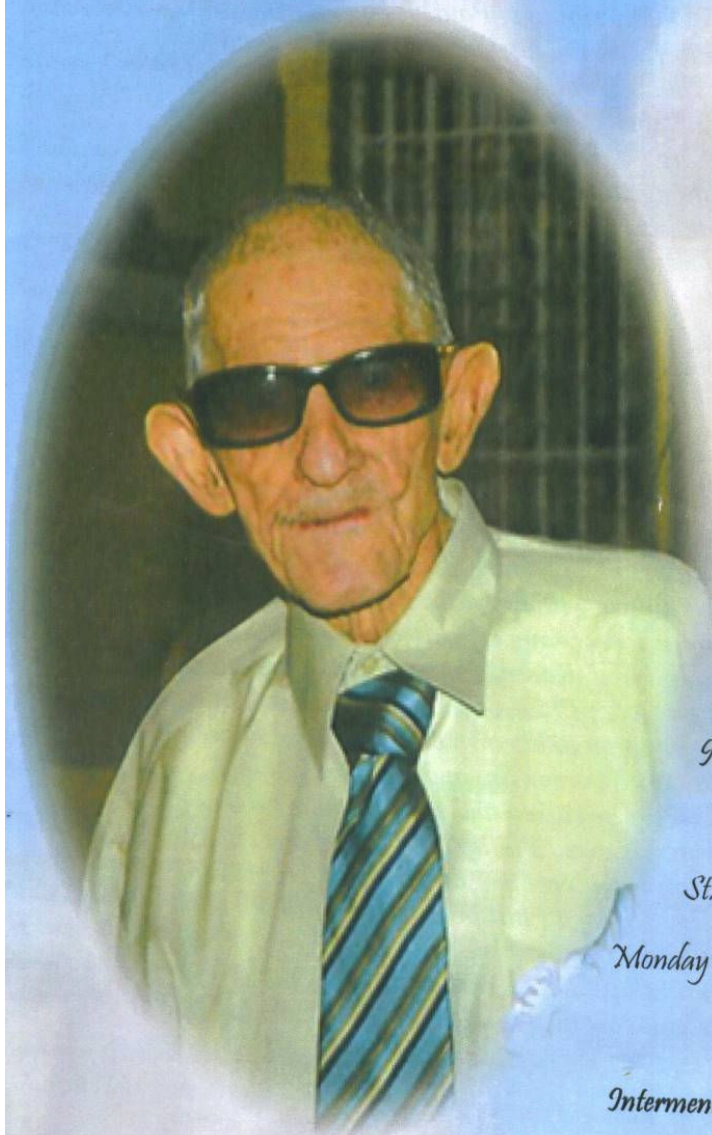

Eulogy



It was on December 15, 1926 when the late Pierre and Arlene Louise Turbe of St. Thomas announced the blessings of their second born son named Phillip "Beal" Turbe. Phillip was known around Frenchtown by several names; Beal, Baker, and even outlaw, but "DADA" was most common among his most dearly closest friends and family. Phillip was one of many siblings: Paul, John, Sylvanie and Peola Turbe alongside the late Joseph, Theodore and Felicia "Vita" Vante. Throughout Phillip's career, he became an active member in the United States Army until his honorable discharge in 1945. Upon his discharge, Phillip began working alongside his father "White Pierre & uncle Black Pierre (deceased)" and his brother Joseph as well as other family members in a butcher meat stall where he learned and later carried on a trade of being a butcher after the passing of his father. Becoming a butcher helped Phillip as he became well known throughout Frenchtown for his butcher lifestyle. He later went on to work at the Dept. of Finance. After a short period of time working at the Dept. of Finance, Phillip went on to work with his brother Joseph at Joe's Meat Market until it was closed. On July 30, 1947, Phillip announced the birth of his first born son, the late Franklin "Boogie" Turbe. In 1956, Phillip met and fell in love with the wonderful Ina Petersen. This loving union later brought forth five children: Ann Turbe-Greaux, Mildred, Karen, Sharon and the late John Turbe. Many years later, Phillip announced the birth of his last born son, Gavin Turbe. In addition to his own children, he also accepted Alford Rhymer Sr., Robert Petersen Sr., and the late Anthony "Hamster" Warner into his life where he raised and showed them no less of love and affection as if they were his own. Phillip was known around as loving, caring, and always helpful son, brother, father, and friend to all those who knew him. As his health declined Phillip was taken into the home of his daughter Sharon and Ina where they had the responsibility of caring, helping and guiding him daily. Phillip "Beal" Turbe passed at the age of 84, in the comfort of his home amongst his loved ones on the morning of September 4, 2011. He was loved greatly and missed by all.
