Eulogy

Titania Magras was born to the late Joyce Francis, and Julian Alvarez Julien on September 24, 1922 on the island of St. Thomas, Virgin Islands. Titania grew up on the island of St. Croix where she lived with her father, and then came to St. Thomas where she met her late husband, Pierre Leopold Magras. They were married on June 5th, 1944 on the island of St. Croix in Chirstiansted. They then resided on St. Thomas. Later they owned and operated L&T Guest House.

God blessed her with Gloria, Jean, Shirley, Pierre Jr, Rosalie, Dolores, Lewis, Barbara, Suzette, Dianne, Patrice and Lakisha. She were blessed with 28 grandchildren, 50 great grandchildren, and 4 great/great grandchildren.

Titania worked as an elementary school teacher for a number of years, and then went to work at the Department of Finance as the Chief of Revenue Audit. She retired after working with Finance and later devoted herself to service in her church the Frenchtown Evangelistic Assembly. She knew each one of her students that she taught, even at the age she was. Whenever she would meet anyone of them she would greet them as if it was just yesterday she had taught them.

In 1996, Titania (Silver Arrow Lady), and her late husband started, and operated a CB Club for which she was president. She and her club was very instrumental in facilitating Vitma, and the American Red Cross during hurricanes, storms, and also other community activities.

Titania became a member of the Frenchtown Evangelistic Church where she served as a choir member, a youth leader, and was very active in bible study. She became a living part of her church. She enjoyed, and always looked forward in participating in the activities, and events of the church. Some of her favorites were bible studies especially helping the youths study for bible challenges with other groups from other churches. She refused to let her age or sickness stop her from being active in the church. She became close with many of the members of the church. The members called her mother.

She became very, very ill, and after surgery, she remained so up until her death at her home on August 9, 2005.
